REGISTRATION CHAMPLAIN SAINT-LAMBERT STUDENTS	<p>Before you request summer school registration, please be sure that the class you need is offered here. If you have any questions, send a MIO to 'Academic Advisor'.</p> <p>The Summer School Registration request form will be available from April 8th to April 13th in Omnivox. Completing this form DOES NOT guarantee your registration.</p> <p>Confirmations of Summer School Registration will be sent out May 29th, 2026.</p>
PAYMENT	PAYMENT OF FEES MUST BE MADE as soon as you are registered.
NUMBER OF COURSES	Students may enrol in a maximum of 2 courses.
DURATION AND COURSE CONTENT	A summer course covers the same material normally taken during a regular session, but in 3 to 5 weeks.
ABSENCES DUE TO ILLNESS	Students who encounter unavoidable problems, such as illness or death in the family, should notify the professor and complete an absence form on Omnivox IMMEDIATELY .
UNEXCUSED ABSENCES	Absences for any reason will be treated according to the IPESL absence policy.
COURSE WITHDRAWAL	To withdraw officially from a course, you must make a request using the "Withdrawals and drops" module on Omnivox. Failure to withdraw will result in a failing grade in the course. (See dates below)
COURSE DROP	The course remains on your schedule and transcript. A remark (AE) will appear on your transcript indicating that you dropped the course. No grade, credit, or R-score is assigned for the dropped course.
